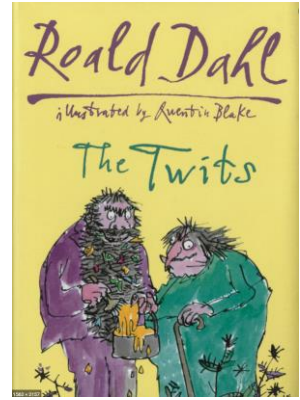

2. What was the name Mrs Twit gave the 'moving spaghetti'? Can you find 2 adjectives she uses to describe it?

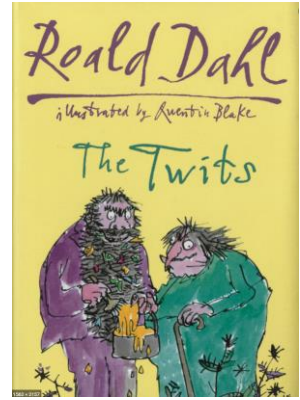
3. Does Mr Twit enjoy the spaghetti? How do you know?

2. What does the word **gradually** mean?

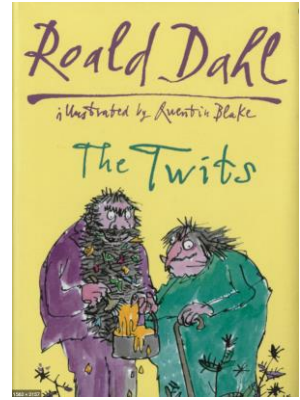
3. Why does it take so long for Mrs Twit to realise something is wrong with her walking-stick? What does she think has happened?

2. What do you think to go 'white with fear' means?

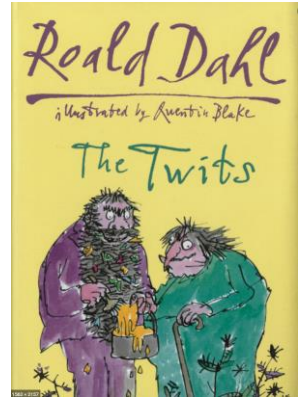

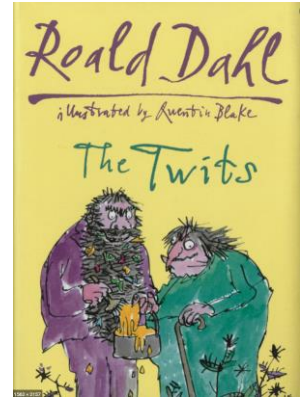
